

Dear Chairwoman Lowey, Ranking Member Granger, Chairwoman DeLauro, and Ranking Member Cole:

Thank you for your past support of the Rural Community Facilities Technical Assistance program authorized under 680(a)(3)(B) of the Community Services Block Grant Act and administered by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). As you are aware, this program has helped hundreds of small rural communities since its establishment over three decades ago. To continue this important work, we write to ask the committee for increased funding in fiscal year 2020 (FY20).

The 2017 American Community Survey and data from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) have shown that over 470,000 American households lack access to water and wastewater systems, and nearly one in four households depends on individual septic system or small community cluster systems to treat their wastewater. Adequate water and waste disposal are an essential element in building a community, improving its economy, creating jobs and reducing poverty. Without clean water or adequate water infrastructure, the development of housing, schools, and commercial and industrial facilities is limited, as is economic growth more broadly.

The principal grantees of the Rural Facilities Technical Assistance grants are Regional Community Assistance Partnerships (RCAPs). RCAPs work with small communities with an average population of 1,000 people that are struggling to maintain and update their wastewater and drinking water systems.

The services financed through this program remain critical. It is our hope that you will continue to support and expand this important program by providing the Rural Community Facilities Technical Assistance program with increased funding in FY 2020.




